

Memorandum of Understanding William James College and College Unbound

This memorandum of understanding (MOU) reflects the formal collaboration between William James College and College Unbound. This collaboration formally begins on October 25, 2024, and runs through September 1, 2027. Founded in 1974 as an independent college of psychology, William James College is the largest psychology educational institution in New England, offering degree programs in mental health and applied psychology at the bachelor's, master's, doctoral and certificate levels. William James College is a leader in educating organizational and behavioral health professionals who are committed to serving and treating our most vulnerable populations. Constantly evolving to meet the needs of a rapidly changing society, the College graduates highly skilled professionals to care for all segments of our population in a variety of settings including schools, courts, the community, and the workplace. William James College is proud to provide alumni and employees of College Unbound with an opportunity to further their education and training with a Master of Arts degree in Organization Psychology from William James College.

William James College commits to:

- Automatically qualify the first 15 College Unbound enrollments per semester for a special College Unbound Scholarship covering \$14,000 of tuition for the MA in Organizational Psychology. Subsequent applicants from CU will automatically qualify for a \$12,000 Partners Scholarship. This will be revisited each year to adjust to a comparable level with tuition increases.
- Waive Application Fees for all College Unbound alumni and employees.
- Reserve 15 seats for College Unbound students, employees, and alumni to attend and participate in the Master's in Organizational Psychology or Doctorate in Leadership Psychology residence days in November or March.
- Dedicate an Admissions Counselor and Faculty member to provide one-on-one consultation and assistance to College Unbound students, alumni, and employees interested in learning more about the MA program in Organizational Psychology
- Host informational programs and webinars for College Unbound students, alumni, and employees.
- Extend a one-on-one interview to all applicants from College Unbound for the MA in Organizational Psychology program.

College Unbound commits to:

- Feature William James College as a partner on the College Unbound website
- Offer on-line sessions and in-person visits to Capstone Courses for students to discuss advanced degrees at William James College.
- Extend invitations to William James College faculty and Admissions to participate in career activities and events online globally and in-person at the Rhode Island Campus.
- Prioritize sharing information and promotional materials provided by William James College to its current students, alumni, and employees, including Advisors, Faculty, and Mentors.
