Doctor of Humane Letters, *honoris causa*

President Emerita and Senior Scholar at Facing History and Ourselves

Margo Stern Strom, President Emerita and Senior Scholar at Facing History and Ourselves, is an international leader in education for justice and the preservation of democracy. Through her commitment to honoring the voices of teachers and students and her deep belief that history matters, she has enabled millions of students and their teachers to investigate the root causes of racism, antisemitism, bigotry and violence. This innovative curricula invites young people to realize their obligations and capabilities as citizens and their capacity to be “upstanders” rather than bystanders in the face of bullying, ostracism, and injustice.

Raised in Memphis, Tennessee, during the struggle for civil rights, Strom’s early career was as a teacher, examining the social and moral issues the day and lessons of history. She ultimately left the classroom to become the founding director of a federally funded Title IV grant that began Facing History and Ourselves. This creative idea quickly grew into an evidence-based national program for promoting civic learning that inspires and supports teachers to do what for so many is the reason they went into teaching in the first place—to make a difference in students’ lives that is profound enough to help them become local and world citizens who make a positive difference in the lives of others.

In the four decades of Strom’s direction, Facing History became a global enterprise, remaining true to its core purpose and values. Its impact on schools, teachers, and students has been recognized by the US Department of Education, as well as by organizations such as the Collaborative for Social and Emotional Learning, the Social Impact Exchange, and the Education Commission of the States.

Robert Lewis Jr

Doctor of Humane Letters, *honoris causa*

Founder and President, The BASE

As a passionate ambassador for our community's youth, Robert Lewis, Jr. is a catalyst of change. His work as a thought leader, educator and coach for urban youth has been nationally recognized for , bridging business, civic and public sectors throughout the country to make positive change a reality for young people. In 2015, Lewis was named one of the city's 50 Most Powerful Leaders by Boston Magazine and in 2016, Lewis was honored by the Boston Business Journal as one of Boston's Top 50 Game-Changers.

Game-changer is an accurate depiction of Lewis' career, which includes leading the National Conference for Community and Justice (NCCJ) as President and Executive Director, Senior Vice President of City Year's national operations and Executive Director of City Year Boston, and Vice President for Program at the Boston Foundation. He was the visionary behind StreetSafe Boston, the country's only privately funded (\$15m) gang program designed to dramatically reduce gun violence in the city.

Lewis' impact on urban youth doesn't end there. In 2013, he focused his mission to shifting the national mindset about what it takes for Black and Latino youth to succeed. As a result, he brought his lifelong dream to reality by launching The BASE. This organization is a model and methodology that changes the paradigm for urban youth by providing student athletes with the opportunity, knowledge, skills and confidence needed to develop a winning game plan for success both on and off the field. The organization reaches about 900 Boston urban youth who are between the ages of 10 and 19, with hopes of expanding to 5,000 young people by 2020. Lewis' vision still plays on today, as The Base continues to pursue a national strategy to change the odds for urban youth across the country. Hall of Famer and legendary baseball writer Peter Gammons has called The BASE "hands-down the best urban baseball program in the country."

It is because of Lewis' vision, passion and personal mission that many of our city's talented youth in are headed around the proverbial base path in a positive direction.

James (Jim) Roosevelt Jr

Doctor of Humane Letters, *honoris causa*

Former CEO, Tufts Health Plan

Advisor to the Board of Directors and CEO of Tufts Health Plan

James Roosevelt, Jr. has broad experience as Chief Executive Officer, Board Chair and Committee Leader of health care public policy professional associations and politics. He was a Visiting Fellow at the Harvard Kennedy School of Government last year and is counsel to the law firm of Verrill Dana.

Roosevelt joined Tufts Health Plan in 1999 as Senior Vice President and General Counsel and held that position until June 2005, when he became President and Chief Executive Officer. As CEO he led a turn-around raising membership from 587,000 to over 1,000,000. Revenue more than doubled and finances stabilized. The health plan entered the Rhode Island and New Hampshire markets and acquired a Medicaid plan. It is now the largest qualified health plan in enrollment on the Massachusetts Affordable Care Act marketplace and the largest Medicare Advantage Plan in New England. Under Roosevelt's leadership, THP's commercial plan received the #1 rating for quality in the US and achieved a five-star rating from the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) for its Medicare Advantage Plan, while becoming one of only 10 Medicaid plans to gain 4.5 stars or above from CMS.

Before joining THP, Roosevelt was Associate Commissioner for Retirement Policy for the Social Security Administration in Washington, DC and had spent 10 years as partner at Choate, Hall and Stewart in Boston.

Roosevelt has always committed himself and offered leadership and support to organizations that he believes in. Today he serves on the board of directors of Alere, chairing its Compensation Committee and serving on its Nominating and Governance Committees. In addition, he continues as a consultant to Tufts Health Plan and is a board member and chair of the policy committee of America's Health Insurance Plans.

He also has played and continues to play a major role on the national stage. In 2008, President-elect Barack Obama appointed him to his transition team to co-chair a review of the Social Security Administration. Today he is a member of the National Academy of Social Insurance and Vice-chair of the Advisory Board of the National Committee to Preserve Social Security and Medicare. Chief Legal Counsel to the Massachusetts Democratic Party, he is also a member of the executive committee and co-chairs the Rules and By-laws Committee of the Democratic National Committee, defining and overseeing the delegate selection process of the Democratic National Convention.
